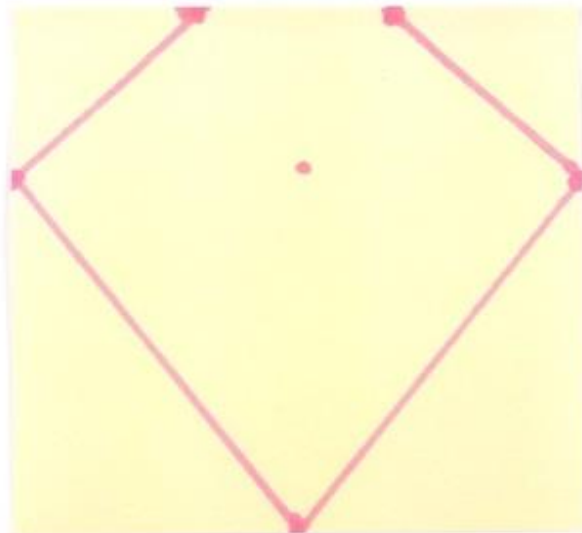


The tessellations of M.C. Escher are the inspiration for this art project.

Using a standard Post-it note or square piece of paper, mark the outer points and inner point of the heart design. It's important that each upper side of the heart be half the length of the bottom side of the heart. This will ensure our hearts fit together like a puzzle.



Make sure the two sides are symmetrical. Then, trace it on to a piece of cardboard or tagboard so it will be firm and easy to trace. Place your first heart near the center of your paper and trace it.

Next, align the pieces and fill your paper with the pattern. Use the sharpie to finish any lines that may not be completed from your tracing. Next, color or paint your hearts. Viola!
